TOO PUMPED FOR A SUMMER SLUMP!

One of the all-time great sports movies is the movie *Miracle*, about the 1980 United States Olympic Hockey Team and their coach, Herb Brooks. In 1980, the Soviet Union's Hockey Team was the most dominant team in hockey, and perhaps in any sport. No U.S. team had won a game against them for 20 years. They had won Olympic championships in 1964, 1968, 1972, and 1976, and had won the World Championships in most of those previous 20 years. The Soviet team regularly trounced even America's professional all-star team in exhibitions, and most of its players were seasoned veterans of 15 years or more of international competition who were paid under the Soviet system to do nothing but train and compete. But in a seven-month period of time, Herb Brooks took a young team of American college hockey players, average age 21, and molded them into a force that defeated the seemingly unbeatable Soviets and went on to win the gold medal. Many of us can remember Al Michaels' famous call as the clock wound down: "Do you believe in miracles? Yes!!!!" What is significant is that in *every single game* the U.S. team won, they came from behind to do so. They never gave up. They never quit. They kept plugging away until they won. It is also interesting to note that one of the reasons the U.S. team succeeded against the Soviets when others failed was Herb Brooks' game strategy: "We're not going to *defend* against them! We're going to *attack* them!" Brooks recognized that other teams were so intimidated by the Russians that they played a defensive game rather than aggressively taking the game to them.

You may be asking what a story about ice hockey has to do with summertime. Summertime can be an intimidating time in church life. As the summer has become more and more compressed, more people will be gone on vacations and other trips on any given Sunday, and summertime attendance usually slumps to its lowest level of the year. And at a time of year when the church's expenses are at their highest, offerings are generally at their lowest. But we're not going to defend against the summer slump, we're going to attack it! It's going to be an exciting summer here at Calvary, and YOUR involvement is needed.

As I am writing this on June 2, it is hard to believe that this Monday begins our **VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL**. This year's theme is "Saddle Ridge Ranch" and the theme verse is James 1:5: "If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who

gives to all generously and without criticizing, and it will be given to him." Pray for all those who will be staffing our VBS this summer, and pray especially for the children who will be confronted with the message of Christ during VBS.

Then, the very next week, our youth and their chaperones will be off to Jekyll Island, Georgia for **SUPERWOW** June 14-18. Pray about what God is going to do in the lives of our youth as they go for this event. Not even a week later, on June 24, our **MISSION TEAM** will depart for Guatemala. In recognition of those who will be going to SuperWow and Guatemala, we will have a special commissioning service for them this Sunday morning, June 6.
