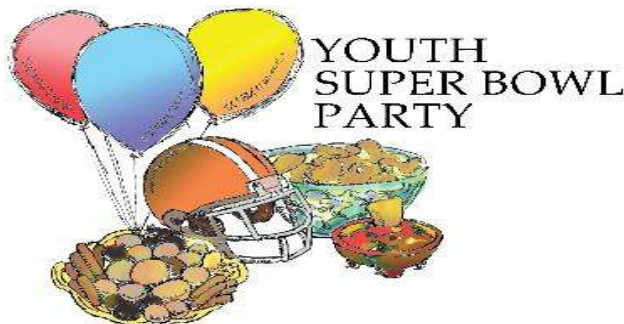

As I drove to the office this morning through the "light wintry mix" (a weather term I'd never heard before moving here), feeling depressed over the Groundhog seeing his shadow (how could he not with all those camera lights focused on him?), I looked up at Bay's Mountain, covered with snow and shrouded by clouds, and thought, "Wow, it's good to be here!" God has blessed us with a wonderful year here in Kingsport, a year filled with all kinds of adjustments and new experiences. We are grateful to God and to you for bringing us here, and thankful for what a wonderful church family He has placed us in, a church family that has fully embraced us and made us feel right at home.

Because of the "Snow Day Sunday," the vote on calling Jon Hoover as our new Children and Youth Minister has been moved to this coming Sunday, February 7. This Sunday, barring any unforeseen weather events, our SOUPER BOWL OF PLANNING will go on as scheduled. If you were one of the key leaders who received the Souper Bowl mailout last week, please make every effort to be here. Your input is both wanted and needed. You can reference the schedule for the day in the letter I sent you. Keep in mind that because of the SOUPER BOWL OF PLANNING, there will be no evening service on February 7.

On February 14, we will be ordaining James Karnes as a new deacon during the morning service.

On February 21, I will be away in Georgia preaching for Caleb Horne's ordination to the gospel ministry. Caleb, if you don't know, is my future son-in-law. He is currently a senior at Brewton-Parker College serving as a youth minister in Rentz, Georgia. He is planning to go to seminary in the Fall after he and Elizabeth graduate in May,

and they will marry December 10. Dr. Dallas Bivins, our Associational Missionary, will be preaching the morning message on February 21, and Bro. Richard Harris will be bringing the message in the evening service.

Looking a little further ahead, I will be away March 6-12, attending the Fresh Oil, New Wine Conference in Hixson, Tennessee at Central Baptist Church. God has used this conference mightily in my life over the past 8 years or so I've been attending it. Pray that God will speak great things into my spirit during this week of spiritual renewal, and that I will return full of the Spirit and re-fired for ministry. On March 14, we will celebrate the Lord's Supper, and on March 28, our choir will present the Easter Cantata "A.D."

COMING SOON ON WEDNESDAY NIGHTS...

On Wednesday night, February 10, I will be talking about St. Valentine as part of our "Great Christians You Should Know" series. What do you know about the saint whose day we celebrate in February? Did you know that there's more than one Valentine? Why is Valentine's Day related to love? What is the origin of Valentine cards? What is the origin of the name of the month "February?" Come and find out next Wednesday!

After our business meeting on the 17th, we will start a new 8-part video series on the 24th called *The Invisible War: What Every Believer Needs to Know about Satan, Demons and Spiritual Warfare*. It has been said that there are two equal and opposite errors we can fall into about the devil – giving him too little of our attention, or giving him too much of our attention. Most studies of spiritual warfare seem to drift off to those extremes as well: either so academic that they are of little practical use, or so "way out" that they are of questionable Biblical moorings. *The Invisible War*, taught by Chip Ingram of Living on the Edge Ministries (www.lote.org), is a thorough, Biblical, and practical study that will open our eyes to the invisible warfare going on all around us, a war that, to quote Tolkien, is upon us, whether we would risk it or not. Chip Ingram has also produced a study guide as a companion to the video

series and a 187-page book containing far more information than he was able to put in the series. If you would like these materials, please call the church office as soon as possible. The study guides are \$7.00 apiece, and the books are \$11.00. You can order either or both, and you can pay for them when they come in.

COMING SOON ON SUNDAY MORNING...

Beginning February 28 and extending through the Easter season, I will begin a series of messages called "Strength for Your Days." Deuteronomy 33:25 tells us "*As your days, so shall your strength be.*" As we look at Jesus' Passion Week, we will see the strength that God offers us when Monday comes (a time of challenge), when Tuesday comes (a time of opposition), when Thursday comes (a time of anxiety), when Friday comes (a time of injustice, betrayal and pain) and when Sunday comes (a time of renewal, refreshing, restoration and victory). Let me encourage you to be here for each of these services.

We will also be continuing our journey through The Greatest Sermon Ever Preached (The Sermon on the Mount) on Sunday evenings through April.

I can't wait to see you all this Sunday, and to see what God's going to do in us, for us, and through us in coming days.
