April is often a month of contrasts. We can experience both winter and summer weather, as well as both the grief of Holy Week and the victory of Easter. April is also observed as **Cancer Control Month**.

What can be done to reduce our risk of the various types of cancer? Seeking Health care at the earliest possible time if you have a change in your health status helps any treatment to be more effective. In addition, it is very important to see your doctor if you experience any of the following warning signs:

- C** hange in bowel or bladder habits
- A** sore that does not heal
- U** nusual bleeding or discharge
- T** hickening or lump in breast or elsewhere
- I** ndigestion or difficulty swallowing
- O** bvious change in a wart or mole
- N** agging cough or hoarseness

If you or a loved one experiences any of these warning signs, it may not indicate anything serious, but if it is related to cancer, it is important to receive health care as soon as possible.

On a different note, I will be joining the Parish Nurse at Mafair Methodist Church to sponsor another blood drive on Tuesday, April 27th from 3:00 – 5:00 at Mafair. In the past we have only had one or two people from Calvary to donate. Please mark this date on your calendar and when you go, be sure and tell them you are from Calvary Baptist Church.
