Dear Calvary,

First, THANK YOU so much for all the support you have so graciously given to our mission team. Your prayers, financial gifts and mission items have been a blessing. As mentioned in our services this past Sunday, this has been a unique journey for our team as we are embarking on a journey to a new mission field in Guatemala while adjusting to new criteria for air travel and items that we can take into the country.

Our mission efforts while in Guatemala are going to include light construction of a widow's home, a medical mission day, VBS type events for children, evangelistic outreach, Happy Feet, delivery of Gospels of John, gospel tracts, medicine and whatever else is needed while we are on the mission field.

Below is a list of items that will assist us in our mission efforts. If you can contribute any of the items below, please bring them to the church and place in 2 X 2 Sunday School Class or to the fellowship hall (after VBS, please). If you wish to donate to help purchase any of these items or a particular item, simply designate that on the memo line of your check AND on the offering envelopes or give them to Jennifer.

- Sweaters, Sweatshirts or Hoodies – mountainous region can get cool in evenings
- Shoes – Mens, womens & childrens - no size larger than 10 for women and no larger than 12 for men, please. Also, minimal heels for ladies. Will take any, big need for tennis shoes, Crocs or generic rubber. No high heels (due to muddy conditions at times).
- Socks
- Photo paper for printing individual photos of villagers – Kodak Easy Share Series 3 Paper and Ink. PH-40 or PH-160.
- Popsicle sticks for crafts and other craft items
- Pencils, Crayons (small crayons – 8 pak size)
- Small hand-held pencil sharpeners

- Coloring books – Christian Spanish stories - \$1.00 each. Would like 25 books to take.
- Elmer's Glue – (5) small bottles
- Clothing – nothing above a size 8 for ladies and nothing above a Large for men.
- Money to feed a village
- Face Painting supplies
- (4) jump ropes
- (10) Frisbees
- (8) Nerf balls – any size
- (4) inflatable beach balls
- (4), wiffle balls & (1) bat
- Hard Candy
- Gospel of John – pack of 300 - \$95.00. (we would like to take at least 600)
- New Testaments – quantity – 50 – cost - \$60.00
- Complete Bibles – limited because of weight - \$80.00
- Generic items of: Band-aids, Neosporin (smallest tubes), Ibuprofen, Tylenol, Insect bite cream, multi-vitamins.
