I would ask you to continue praying for Caleb as he is launching out on the journey of ministry. Pray also as he and Elizabeth are moving toward graduation in May, planning their wedding, and moving to Louisville for Caleb to attend THE Southern Baptist Theological Seminary. And certainly, we covet your prayers for Robin as she recovers from her surgery and begins follow-up treatments.

It was so good to be back at Calvary this past Sunday. One of the wonderful things about being a Christian is that you can go anywhere in the world, and if you can find a group of Christians, you're immediately with family. We felt that family embrace with the wonderful congregation in Rentz, Georgia at the ordination service, but that being said, there's no place like home! There is a special bond of love that develops with one's home congregation, and we've found that bond here. I'm reminded of the old gospel song that said, "I love the thrill that I feel when I get together with God's wonderful people!" Coming to worship here for me is not a job, but a joy.

Next week, from March 6-12, I will be in Chattanooga for the Fresh Oil New Wine Conference at Central Baptist Church of Hixson. One of my ministry heroes, Dr. Ron Phillips (who taught via DVD our Wednesday series on "Hidden Hindering Spirits" last year), has been pastor there for 30 years, and I've been privileged to attend their yearly conference for the last 9 years. God has used this conference in my life as a wonderful time of renewal and refreshment for me each year, and I would ask you to pray that my heart, my mind, my ears and my will would be attuned to what God would say to me during this week. While I am away next week, our new Children and Youth Minister, Jon Hoover, will be preaching the morning service on March 7, and Bro. Lamar Herndon will be bringing the message Sunday night. On Wednesday night, Bro. Richard Harris will be in charge of the service. I can't tell you how blessed I am as a pastor (and how blessed we are as a congregation) to know that when I must be away, I am leaving the church services in good hands with Jon, Richard, Lamar and our Associational Missionary Dallas Bivins, who filled in for me a couple of weeks

ago. It's also good to know that Mikel and our deacon body are here to respond to any needs of the congregation during the week.

Speaking of Wednesday nights, I'm very excited about the upcoming lessons we will begin on March 24 on the subject of *The Invisible War: What Every Believer Needs to Know about Satan, Demons and Spiritual Warfare*. This is a balanced, Biblical and practical 8-part series taught by Chip Ingram of Living on the Edge Ministries in Atlanta. Chip has produced a companion book and workbook for the video series, and we are making those available to those who call the church office and let us know to order them. The books are \$6.00 apiece, and the workbooks are \$7.00, and you can pay for them when they come in. Make plans to be here for this important, interesting, and informative series.

When I return on March 14, we will observe the ordinance of the Lord's Supper in the morning service. Don't forget to spring forward one hour on March 13 before bed. I will also be continuing our series on Jesus' Passion Week with the message "Strength for Your Days #2 – When Tuesday Comes..." Tuesday of Passion Week was a day of harassment and opposition for Jesus. Come see what His actions that day can teach us about handling that kind of opposition in our lives. Then on Sunday evening, we'll continue our journey through the Sermon on the Mount with the message, "Don't Worry...Be Happy" from Matthew 6:25-34. Make plans to be here for each of those services. Don't let little distractions or little inconveniences keep you from the Lord's house. If the devil knows there's something he can send your way that will keep you from church, don't be surprised if that package arrives every Sunday! Refuse delivery! Slam the door and sing a chorus of "Return to Sender!" It's just smelly garbage spray-painted gold anyway! The real treasure is found in the Lord's house on the Lord's Day with the Lord's people being taught the Lord's Word! Come see what gold we can discover together!
