Here we go again. I'm referring to VBS. We embark on another year of a wonderful journey with our children. This year our theme is Saddle Ridge Ranch, Drivin'Home Answers. Water Bottles

If you're concerned about toxic chemicals from reusable plastic water bottles, choose a bottle made of stainless steel or a plastic that does not contain BPA (bisphenol A).

Many manufactures no longer sell bottles made from polycarbonate plastic that contains BPA, a chemical that can leach out with regular use. In some studies, BPA has been linked to an increased risk of ovarian and breast cancer, as well as developmental problems in kids.
