Last Sunday, we had our special Evangelistic Service and God blessed us with two young men being saved, one during the service and one after. To God be the glory!

And there's much more to come! Just looking at the calendar for the next couple of months makes me feel tired. But then I'm reminded that I'm not in this alone. I have the best staff (professional and laity) that any shepherd could ask for.

Here's what's coming up in the coming weeks:

SUNDAY MORNINGS: On Sunday mornings, we continue our Series of Special Sundays with the Lord's Supper on May 30, a Commissioning Service for our Mission Teams on June 6, VBS Commencement on June 13, Father's Day on June 20, Stewardship Sunday on June 27, and Patriotic Celebration on July 4.

SUNDAY EVENINGS: On May 30, June 6, and June 13, we will continue our study of the book of Jude. There will be no evening service on June 20 (Father's Day), or July 4. On June 27, our youth will report on their trip to SuperWow, and on July 11, our Guatemala mission team will give their report.

WEDNESDAY EVENINGS: In our Wednesday night service, we have just completed an 8-part study of spiritual warfare, and we are moving right into a new study on the subject of intercessory prayer. This study, taught by Dutch Sheets, will begin June 2 and continue through August 3 (except for business meeting nights on June 16 and July 14). This study will lead into the formation of a Pastor's Prayer Force ministry that will focus the prayer energy of the church in coordinated, specific, and strategic ways.

Beyond our regular services, we have Vacation Bible School June 7-11 and SuperWOW at Jekyll Island, Georgia June 14-18. Our mission team will going to Guatemala

June 24 – July 3, and Village Fest will be on July 10. Then comes Children's Camp July 12-14.

Of course, personally, I am looking ahead to the marriage of my beloved daughter Elizabeth, in whom I'm well-pleased, to Caleb Horne on July 31 in Guyton, Georgia.

As school gets out and summer sets in, it's very easy for a church to fall into a "summer slump" in terms of attendance and finances as people are out of town for vacations and pursuing other summer activities. Let's determine right now to cancel the summer slump by attending faithfully, giving generously, and praying fervently. Make all of the above, but especially the youth and mission trips, matters of continual, fervent prayer.
