21 DAYS

Twenty-one days. Three weeks. 504 hours. 30,240 minutes...you get the idea. There's something powerful about 21 days. I'm told that any habit can be broken in 21 days, and anything done each day for 21 days becomes a habit. Hmmm...

As I announced this past Sunday, there are 21 days from last Sunday to Easter Sunday. It is my desire that these three weeks be weeks of prayer and outreach leading up to that most significant date on the Christian calendar, the celebration of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Surveys tell us that when asked why they don't go to church, a significant number of unchurched people reply, "Nobody ever asked me." Research also shows that the unchurched and especially the formerly churched are most likely to respond to an invitation to worship during the Easter season. Toward that end, we have designed and printed formal invitations to be given out by our church members during the remainder of this 21 day emphasis. The text of that invitation reads as follows:

*You Are Cordially Invited
To A Celebration of the Most Significant Event in Human
History...*

The Resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ!

*Easter Sunday
April 4
10:30 A.M.
Calvary Baptist Church
1238 Pine Street
Kingsport, Tennessee*

Also included in the invitations are directions to the church, information about the Easter cantata, and a schedule of our regular service times.

This "21 Days" outreach has three parts: prepare, pray, and proceed!

We are currently in the process of preparing the invitations. Our deacons will be praying over these invitations at their meeting tonight, and we will pray over them tomorrow during the business meeting. I am asking anyone who feels the call to intercession to come to the church office between now and Sunday to spend some time in prayer over them. Pray that these invitations will come into the hands of those who most need to hear the message of the gospel at Easter. Pray that those who receive them will be drawn to come and hear the gospel, and that God will prepare their hearts between now and then to receive the gospel.

Then on Sunday, the invitations will be available for our church members to take and distribute prayerfully as the Lord leads for the last 2 weeks until Easter. These invitations are perfect for putting in someone's hand, leaving on the table at a restaurant (along with a big tip!), or leaving on a windshield or in someone's door. Of course, the most effective use of them will be accompanied by a personal invitation to friends, relatives, co-workers and neighbors. Pray about each invitation as you give it out, and pray that God will send a harvest come Easter.

21 Days. The clock is ticking. Will you do your part?
